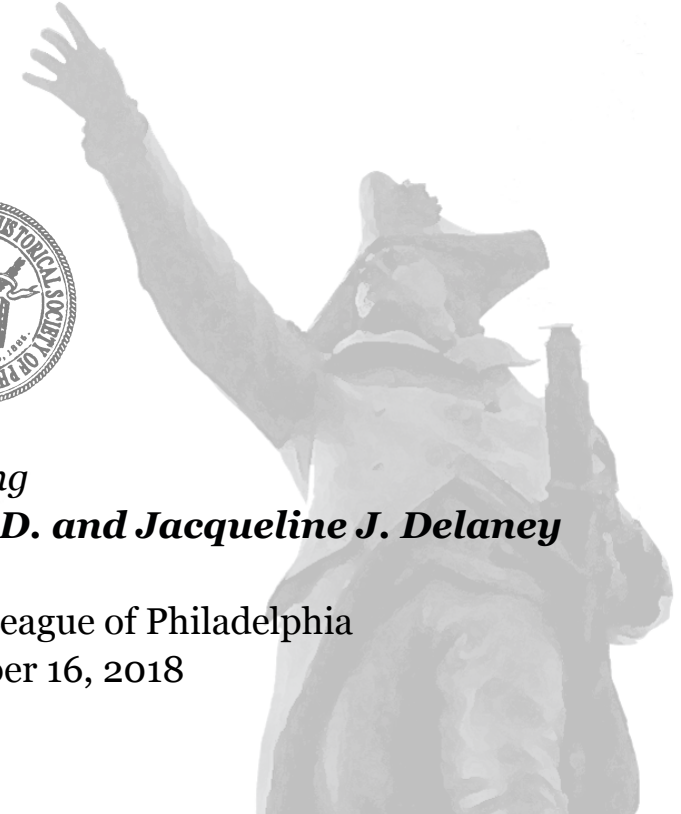

He is also the former Chairman of the Board at Neumann University, and Trustee and Treasurer and Chair of Finance and Audit Committee of Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary.

Jacki has been Chair of the very successful annual Archbishop's Christmas Benefit for Children since 2008.
