He began his pro career while in Australia in 2012. 2 fights and 2 wins later, he returned home to Dublin in 2014 where he made his Irish debut at the 3Arena, against Declan Geraghty. The 4 round bout became 'fight of the year' in Ireland and gave him an opportunity to contest in the Prize Fighter tournament in London the following month. Unknown to the UK boxing scene, he won the tournament and firmly established himself as a hot prospect.

In 2017, still undefeated from 13 fights, he fought against John Quigley in Belfast to win the vacant IBF European Super-Featherweight Title. Not resting on his title win, Carrol went up against Humberto de Santiago from Mexico 5 months after fighting Quigley. A 3rd round TKO victory meant Carrol became the new IBF Inter-Continental Super Featherweight champion.
