ID Languages is based in Bundoran, the surf capital of Ireland and gateway to Donegal, “the coolest place on the planet”, according to National Geographic (and the coolest place in the Wild Atlantic Way, according to us).

Here are our reasons:

- Bundoran is conveniently located between the mountains and the sea, offering stunning cliff walks, hikes and water sports at our doorstep. It has two beaches (Main Beach & Tullan Strand) and several natural sea pools. Rougey walk, the Fairy Bridges and the Westend Cliff walk are some of our favourite spots.
- No commute: our students live within a 15km radius of ID Languages (however, most live in town, within walking distance). Under 18s are accompanied to school by their host families.
- Safety: Bundoran is a small community where everybody knows everybody, therefore we all look after each other. It is a quiet town during the winter months and a very busy place during the summer months (the funfair and indoor water park open during the summer season).
- Affordability: we enjoy very low rent prices in the North West. Even though holiday makers put their prices up during the summer months, standard long-term rent for a 3-bedroom house ranges from €100/week to €150/week. Excellent news for adult students looking for longer stays.
- Healthy community: Bundoran is home to some very cool businesses, whose motto is sustainability. The local 6-screen cinema projects both big movies and small movies, supporting local filmmakers and film festivals. The library offers free activities weekly. Buoy & Gulls is a creative space for local artists where you can buy local craft, have delicious coffee and eat the best toasties in town. The Salty Fox offer healthy meals 7 days a week, Hardy Baker has great bakes and coffee, Milish is a super tasty bakery. The list goes on. 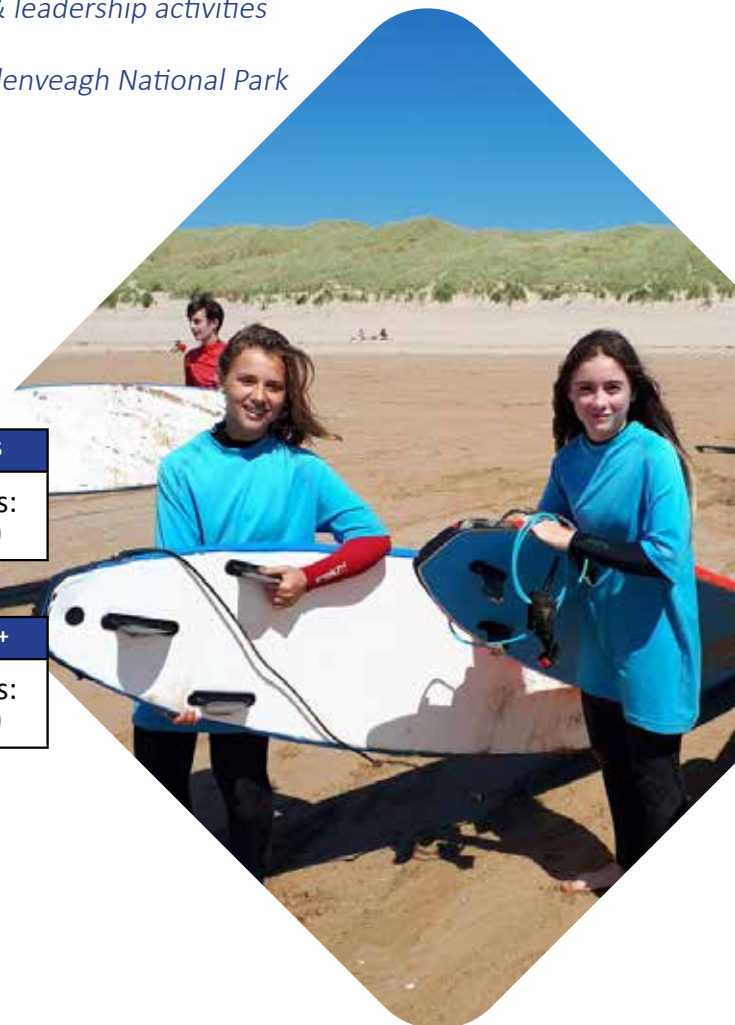
