Thank you for volunteering your time to help the Irish Community Relief Effort. You are a part of an incredibly stong and proud community!

We appreciate your help at this time of crisis and uncertainty. While we understand the desire to "jump-in" there are several points that we need to consider in all this work being completed:

1. Confidentiality is important. We ask that you do not discuss those requesting or receiving food package accept with the lead volunteer at your site.

2. Please be sure that your hands have been thoroughly scrubbed with soap and warm water prior to beginning any work.

3. Please use the gloves available to handle all material.

4. All canned or baxed material must be wiped down with a disinfectant prior to packaging in the individual or family food packages. (see <u>this video</u>).

5. Any deliveries to homes must be left on the porch and the occupant either called or texted with a mesage that a delivery has been made.

6. As in all things, if you are feeling unwell, please stay home and get well.

7. We do not have face masks available but encourage you to wear one of your choice if it makes you more comfortable.
